Towards this end, Environmental Inks & Coatings does not use raw materials or manufacture products which contain mercury, cadmium, lead, or hexavalent chromium as an integral portion of the product nor does Environmental Inks and Coatings intentionally add any of these materials during the manufacturing process. Environmental Inks and Coatings hereby certifies that all inks and related products manufactured by Environmental Inks and Coatings comply with the requirements of CONEG and the Toxics in Packaging law(s). Specifically:


1) We certify that the regulated metals – lead, mercury, cadmium, and hexavalent chromium -- were **not intentionally added** to any EIC product or product component during the manufacturing process.

2) We further certify that the **sum of the incidental concentration levels** of lead, mercury, cadmium and hexavalent chromium present in any EIC product or product component does not exceed 100 parts per million by weight.

This certification applies to all materials as delivered to your facility. This certification excludes Environmental Inks & Coatings from all liability once the products has been removed from its original packaging, or has been handled in any manner which alters its original state.

Please note that Environmental Inks & Coatings' certification of compliance is based on sample testing and/or information from its suppliers, and EIC cannot be held responsible for any faulty or invalid information provided by those suppliers. Environmental Inks & Coatings does not have a specific analysis of each of the several thousand products it manufactures. If you or your customer require empirical evidence that none of these substances are in the ink, then EIC would recommend that you submit samples to an independent laboratory for testing.
